REPAIR CAFES ETC

Heathfield/Horam Repair Café meets in Horam Village Hall every second Saturday of the month, 9.30-12 noon and as the name suggests is a community café with the possibility of having your household goods repaired.



Forest Row Repair Cafe aims to help reduce waste by encouraging a repair culture in our community. A repair can save time, money and waste. The Forest Row Repair Cafe is held in The Forest Row Community Centre, Hartfield Road, Forest Row on the 3rd Saturday of every month except December. Whilst you wait for a repairer we have a cafe for you to enjoy a delicious cup of tea or coffee and a piece of homemade cake donated by local businesses.

Mayfacs Repair Cafe Bring your repairs along to the Mayfacs Shed from 10am to 1pm on the third Saturday of the month, enjoy tea and cake and get to know the repairers. All repairs are assessed in the workshop. Last repair accepted 12:15pm. Enquiries 01435 875888

Repair Café Uckfield repairs broken items brought in by the local community. The cafe is part of an international scheme worldwide that aims to restore broken goods rather than binning them. Having opened in Spring 2022, the Uckfield Repair Cafe - run by a team of around 15 volunteers at the Victoria Pavilion - opens every fourth Saturday of the month from 9:30am to 12 noon Whether members of the public have a broken lamp, radio, TV, bicycle or lawn mower, the volunteers at the café team together to fix these items for free for customers to prevent them having to buy new.

Groombridge Mens' Shed was created by the drive and ambition of a few local people who recognised the needs of people in Groombridge and surrounding villages for a place where they can let their hair down and have a chat while maybe do some crafting, woodwork or jewellery making. You might have something that you want to make or want to be involved in projects that help the local community. You will find us at the back of the village car park in Groombridge where we have a purpose-built workshop with a wide range of tools and equipment. Come on down and have a look
